■ <u>Self-advocate</u>. Reach out to teachers, counselors, family members, and peers when you need help.

☐ Plan out your work schedule for the week, considering the online learning schedule, your teacher's office hours, independent study and reading time, and any collaborative time with group members.



☐ Start your Online Learning Day early. Waiting until the late afternoon



or evening to start your work adds unnecessary stress and creates missed opportunities for collaboration and feedback.




- □ <u>Divide activities into smaller chunks of time</u>. Take short breaks to increase focus and stay motivated to complete tasks on time.


☐ Ask your teacher questions! Use email and the Canvas inbox.
